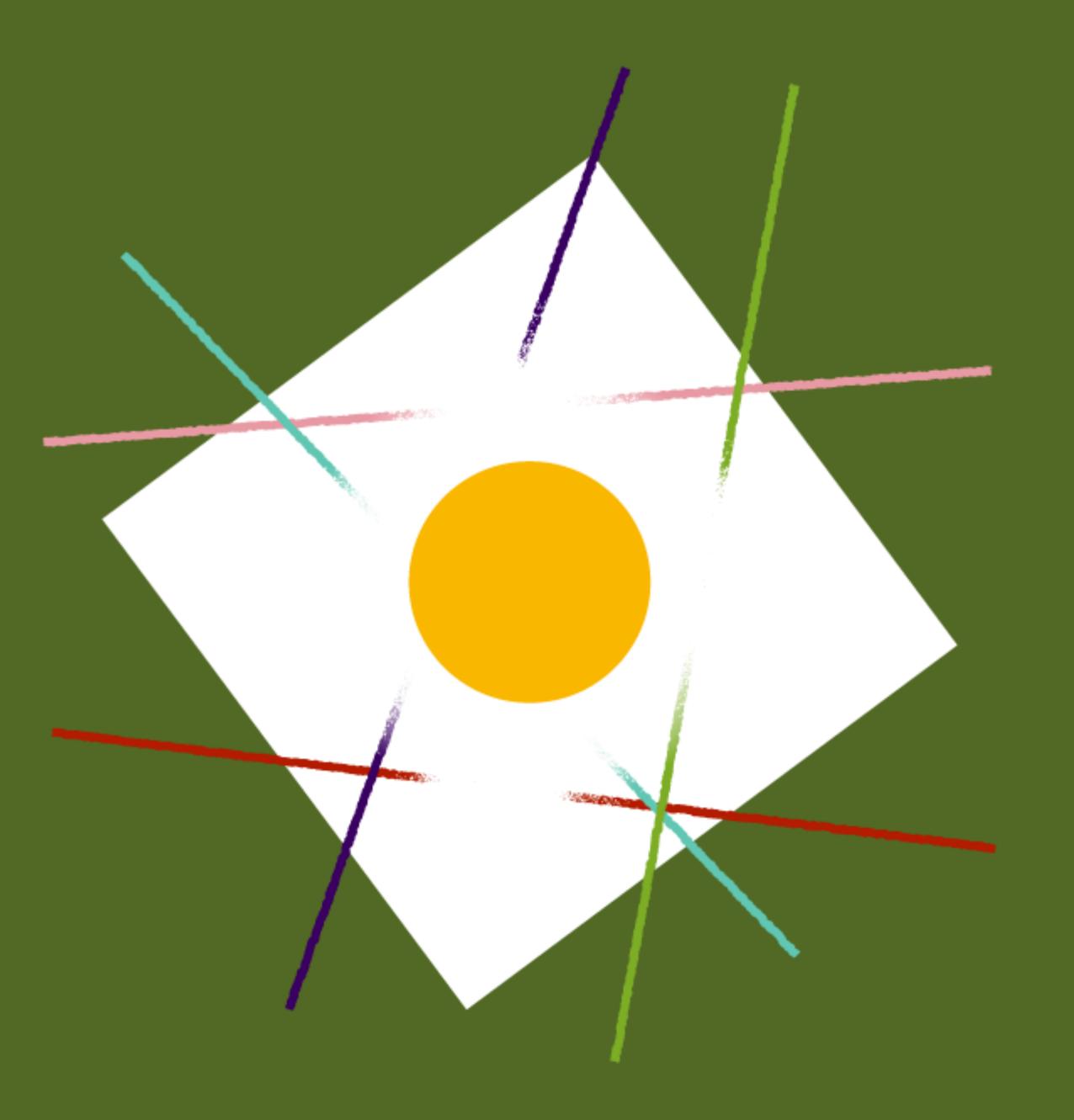

May this story bless the ones who are to come.


The two-step pattern

"The first half of the Gospel emphasizes the coming of God's rule in acts of power and mercy, and the second half emphasizes the persecution that results from living out God's rule in this age. The many smaller two-step progressions prepare listeners to be drawn more readily into seeing this larger second step of the overall narrative and accepting this clearer and more comprehensive view of Jesus" (Rhoades 50-51).

Outsiders, together, responsive, powerful



Jesus creates safety & invites reflection


